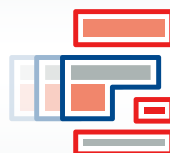
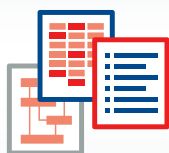

Sitecore CMS Development

Priocept was appointed by the Association of British Insurers to select, design and implement a new content management system for the abi.org.uk website.

After selection of Sitecore as the preferred CMS, Priocept implemented an all-new website, including migration of content into Sitecore from the legacy CMS platform, implementation of sophisticated search features using Solr, and a bespoke integration between Sitecore and ABI's CRM platform.



Sitecore Platform Enhancements

Priocept worked with etyres.co.uk to help them resolve numerous functional, usability and performance issues with their Sitecore-based website.

Priocept took custody of the existing platform and codebase from a previous supplier and worked through a programme of remediation and software quality improvements to deliver a more stable and effective Sitecore solution.



Sitecore Performance Tuning

HiFX were experiencing performance issues with their Sitecore platform which seriously affected the quality of the user experience and overall site reliability.

Priocept worked with HiFX to complete extensive load testing, performance analysis and identification of bottlenecks, and implementation of both architectural and code-level changes to deliver a higher performance CMS platform.



Sitecore Based E-Commerce Platform

Priocept worked with Virgin Mobile to implement an international web presence on Sitecore. This included support for both English and Arabic languages for Virgin Mobile's presence in the Middle East, as part of a joint venture with Qatar Telecom (Qtel).

The new website was built from the ground up, including a Sitecore based content management implementation and integration with back-end Qtel services to implement mobile number provisioning and billing.
